

("Ronsons") and on September 4, 2020, the Court granted an Order adjudging Ronsons bankrupt, and appointing MNP Ltd. as Licensed Insolvency Trustee ("Trustee") of the bankrupt Estate.

^{2.} Prior to the date of bankruptcy, and pursuant to an Order pronounced on April 20, 2020 by the Honourable Madam Justice Fitzpatrick of the Supreme Court of British Columbia, MNP Ltd. was appointed as Receiver and Manager (the "Receiver") of Ronsons' assets, undertakings and property.

- 3. The Receiver realized upon all of Ronsons' assets and will pay the priority claims as directed by the Court. TD is the primary secured lender and will not be paid in full. As such, there are no funds available for the Trustee on behalf of the unsecured creditors.
- 4. The costs of administering the bankruptcy proceedings were paid by the Receiver with the authorization of TD.
- 5. There was one Inspector appointed to the bankruptcy estate. However, the Inspector passed away in April 2021.
