We advised that it was the Insolvent and Trustee's view that, because of the significant decrease in anticipated recovery, the Court's direction was required. Your Lordship has been kind enough to set this down to be heard on Tuesday October 12, at 2 p.m.

Attached with this correspondence is a revised notice of motion.

I have read Ms. Hirschfeld's correspondence to the Court of today's date. The competition here is between her client and that of Mr. Dunning.
