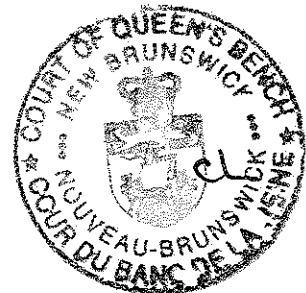

ORDER

AND UPON hearing from counsel for the Applicant;

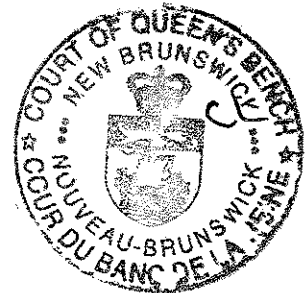
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

SERVICE OF MOTION

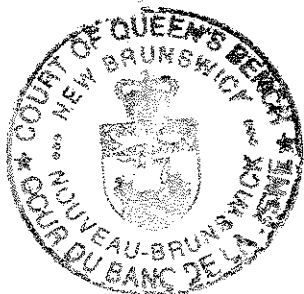
