DEFINED TERMS

1. THIS COURT ORDERS that capitalized terms used in the Order and not otherwise

defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the First Report and the

Supplemental Report.

DISPOSITION OF INVENTORY

2. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Receiver is hereby empowered and authorized, but not

obligated to sell the Inventory, including the raw material wheat, in the flour mill located at 155

Adams Boulevard (the "Flour Mill") on such terms as the Receiver shall determine.

APPROVAL OF RECEIVER'S REPORT AND ACTIVITIES

3. THIS COURT ORDERS that the First Report and the Supplemental Report, and the

activities of the Receiver described therein are hereby approved, excluding paragraphs 2.4.4

and 3.1.7 of the First Report; provided that only the Receiver, in its personal capacity and only

with respect to its own personal liability, shall be entitled to rely upon or utilize in any way such

approval.

4. THIS COURT ORDERS that this Order is effective from the date that it is made and is

enforceable without any need for entry and filing.
